At Welcome to Yorkshire, we encourage our staff and visitors to walk, cycle and use public transport where possible, as part of a healthy lifestyle and our commitment to reducing our environmental impact.

Welcome to Yorkshire

Welcome to Yorkshire is located approximately 700 metres from Leeds railway station, within the Holbeck Urban Village redevelopment - see map below or

Please note our postcode is not showing the correct location on Google Maps and similar applications – use LS11 5WH for our approximate location off Water Lane.

On foot

The flat walk from Leeds Railway Station along wide pavements takes 7-12 minutes.

1. Leave the Railway Station via the double doors, with the Journeys Friend and Paperchase shops on your left (Exit 1 City Centre).
2. Cross over the road using the pedestrian crossing and enter the round stairway leading from the station to Neville Street.
3. Go down the steps and at the bottom turn sharp right, to pass through the Neville Street Tunnel.
4. Walk past the Hilton Hotel, go over Victoria Bridge and take the next right into Water Lane, just before the Bridgewater Place skyscraper. Keep following this road for approximately 200m.
5. Just after Water Lane forks left, you'll pass the Midnight Bell pub on the left. Turn left through the archway next to the pub into Foundry Square and we are located on the right hand side.

To avoid the stairs, on leaving the station turn left and follow New Station Street until reaching the pedestrian crossing. Cross the road at the crossing and turn right into Bishopgate Street. Follow this around until it becomes Neville Street and you enter Neville Street Tunnel. Follow the instructions above from 4. onwards.

By bicycle

Cyclists can follow the walking route above which avoids the stairs. There are bicycle racks located to the right of our main entrance and Welcome to Yorkshire has shower facilities.

By public transport

Getting to Leeds by public transport couldn't be easier, with frequent train services from London and other mainline stations. For information on train fares and up-to-the-minute details of service changes go to <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/> or call 08457 48 49 50.

There is a Bus Interchange at the New Station Street entrance to the Railway station for most bus routes around the city. Approximately 65% of the city's buses are fully accessible.

By car

From the A1/A64

Follow signs for the M1 then...

From the M1

1. At M1 J43 (northbound) or M1 J44 (southbound) follow the signs onto the M621 (signposted Leeds (Centre)). Exit the M621 at J3 following signs for City Centre.
2. Following the bus lane, stay in the left hand lane.
3. Immediately after the bus lane, move over to the left hand lane past Bewleys Hotel on the left and take the third left into Water Lane.
4. Where Water Lane forks left, follow the road around to the right (Globe Road), where you will find a number of pay & display car parks.

Once parked, retrace your steps to Water Lane and just after Water Lane forks left, you'll pass the Midnight Bell pub on the left. Turn left through the archway next to the pub into Foundry Square and we are located on the right hand side.

From the M62

1. Exit the M62 at J27 and join the M621. Exit the M621 at J3, following the signs for City Centre.
2. Follow 2-4 from above.
